## NORMS FOR THE SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

12-point Arial Font, single-space between lines in 8,5 x 11 sheet. MS Word format, version 6.0 or higher. No more than 250 words.

The following information must be included:

- Title (centered in capital letter)
- Specify the Number (From 1 to 26) of the thematic Event for submitting your proposal
- Main author's full name, zip code and e-mail.
- Coauthors' full name
- Name of the Institution, province and country
- Structure of the abstract: introduction, objectives, methods, results and conclusions.
- Keywords: up to 6 words

#### FULL PAPER FEATURES FOR THE SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATION OF THE EVENT

After being reviewed and approved by the Scientific Committee for the presentation in the event, each author will be requested for their corresponding full paper, as well as the additional materials used in the presentation in order to be included in the CD containing the Proceedings of the Event. This document must have up to 20 pages in the same format of the abstract, and it must be made following the Norms of publication of the American Psychological Association (APA).

The deadline for Full Papers submission is: **February 15**<sup>th</sup>, **2016**.

Pre-Congress Courses will be also run (from May 9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016) by experienced professionals, local and abroad, with a 4 or 8-hour duration, for 25.00 CUC.
